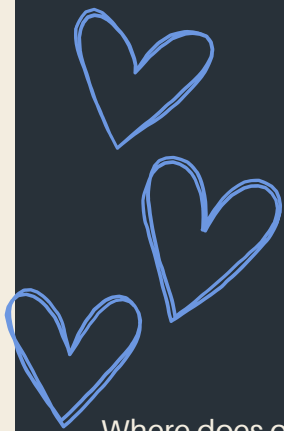

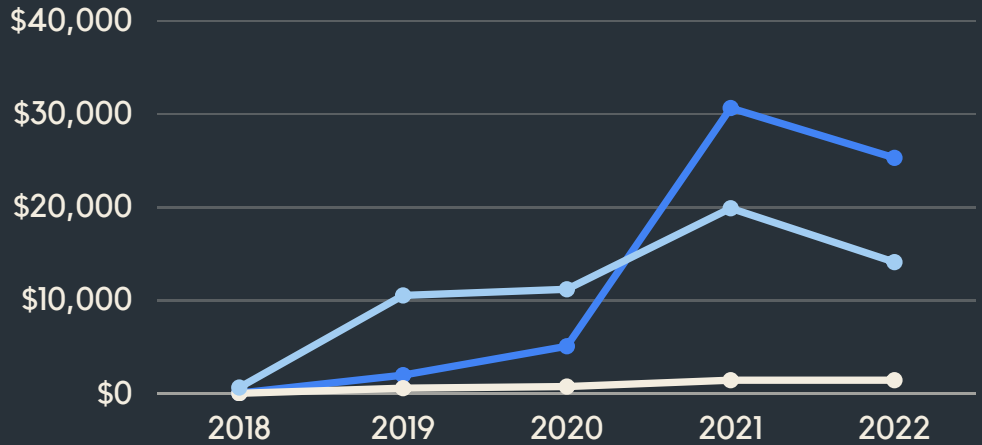

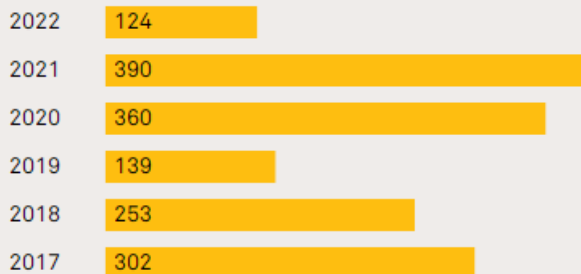
Where does our funding get used? We are a young organization that operates in a big way!

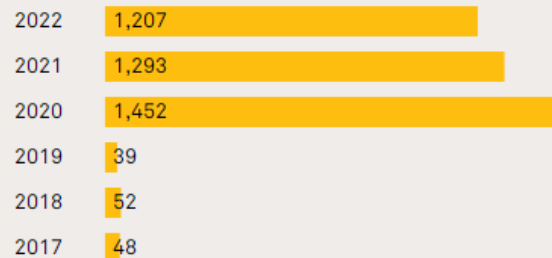

# Our Mission, Vision, Goal

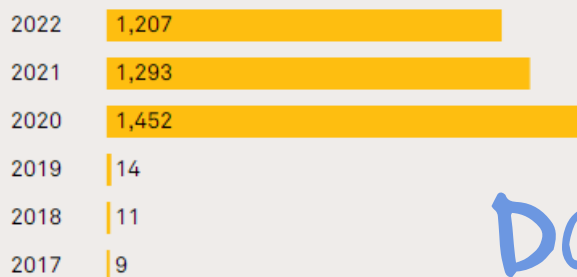

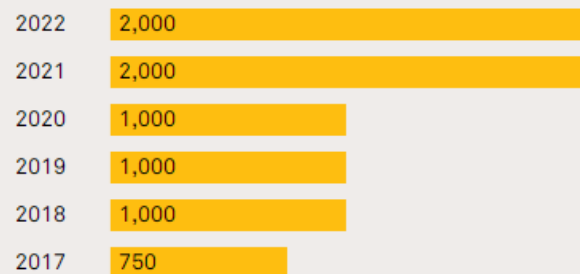
